Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

The [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), very spectacularly located amidst the dramatic Deir el-Bahri cliffs, is one of the most attractive and almost intact ancient Egyptian temples. This incredible temple-mortuary was constructed to pay tribute to one of the very few female pharaohs of the ancient Egyptian civilization. The ruler's splendour and her allegiance to the god Amun are depicted through the temple's terraces, statues, and relief carvings. Upon entering the temple with your guide, you will become acquainted with the tale of Hatshepsut—how she ascended in a male-dominated society and how her story still fascinates scholars and the public.

Colossi of Memnon:

The [Colossi of Memnon](#) have been standing at the entrance of the mortuary temple of Amenhotep III, located on the west side of the Nile near Luxor, for more than three millennia. Each figure is approximately 18 meters (60 feet) tall and is made from a single piece of sandstone.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, [the Colossi of Memnon](#) have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.
